
User Access to Rodent Facility

Access rules - Ground Floor Barrier area:

Access only if in the last 72 hours:

• There has been no contact with rodents outside the facility (including reptiles fed on rodents)

Access only if in the last 24 hours:

• There has been no entrance to a unit with a lower barrier status (First Floor_ experimental Floor)

ROUTING

Access rules II

- Admission and authorization to the unit only after tour of the unit
- Eating or drinking NOT ALLOWED
- Two types of **PERSONAL ACCESS CARD CREDENTIALS**: GROUND FLOOR barrier and FIRST FLOOR recovery rooms barrier.
- At **entering a barrier zone** (Ground Floor; First-Floor Recovery Rooms), put on lab coat, hairnet, mask, gloves, shoe covers or clogs and make sure legs are covered.
- On the First-floor unit at entering an experimental room or lab put on minimally a WHITE Lab coat, mask, and gloves. WHITE Lab coats should be changed weekly.
- Wash your hands before leaving the Facility.
- All visitors must be authorized prior to the visit. Rodent Facility Registration is required before entry.

Working in the Rodent Facility

- New DGAV credited users should be supervised by a qualified Research Team supervisor, capable of personally carrying out the procedures, who is present in the room.
- Only after training and assessment of competency, a new user may work by himself and have independent access.
- Performing procedures only allowed to DGAV accredited users, after registration with the Animal Welfare body (ORBEA) as part of the research team.
- No handling of animals without appropriate PPE.
