COURSE PRESENTATION

Colposcopy is an indispensable examination in modern gynaecological practice and requires continuous updating and learning. This advanced course consolidates the foundations acquired in the basic course and, through the discussion of clinical cases and interpretation of images, contributes to differentiation in this area, constituting one of the SPCPTGI's accreditation modalities in Colposcopy.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

- To consolidate the knowledge acquired in the basic course: anatomy and histology of the cervix, colposcopy technique, concept of transformation zone, concept of disease; pre-invasive lesions, the benefits of screening for pre-invasive lesions, the biology and pathophysiology of HPV, the benefits and limitations of HPV immunisation;
- Understand the techniques used to treat pre-malignant lesions of the lower genital tract;
- Understand the protocols for dealing with changes in screening.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

To consolidate the knowledge acquired in the basic colposcopy course and to understand the techniques for treating lesions.

WHY THE NEED FOR THE COURSE?

The aim of this course is to provide differentiation in the area of lower genital tract pathology, which is necessary for certification to practise colposcopy.

COURSE AREA

Gynaecology.

TEACHING METHODOLOGIES

The teaching methodology is organised using the active pedagogical method, comprising theoretical presentations and practical application through the presentation and discussion of clinical cases. Seminar with presentation by successful candidates of an individual assignment, assessed in person by a jury to be appointed.

LEARNING ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGIES

The course will be assessed through a written test comprising 50 questions, and a minimum of 60 per cent correct answers is required to pass this test. Trainees who attend the entire course and pass the assessment (written test) (minimum 60 per cent correct answers) may be issued with a Diploma (without ECTS). The final classification of the diploma is expressed in the 10-20 range of the integer numerical scale from 0 to 20. The Diploma with ECTS will only be awarded to those who cumulatively: attend the entire course, pass the written test and present a seminar paper.

METHODOLOGY FOR ASSESSING TEACHING QUALITY

At the end of the course, an anonymous FCM|NMS teaching evaluation questionnaire will be administered so that trainees can evaluate the course in terms of its objectives and programme content, teaching methodologies, assessment process and teaching staff.
