International selection competition procedure for the hiring of a PhD holder under Articles 18 and 20 of Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, as amended by Law No. 57/2017, of July 19.

Pursuant to the provisions of article 11, paragraph 2, of Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, it becomes public that by Dean's decree of April 6, 2022, the opening of an international selection competition procedure was authorized for the completion of a PhD holder job vacancy for the exercise of scientific research activities financed by Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia (FCT), I. P., under an uncertain fixed-term employment contract under the Labor Code in the Faculdade de Ciências Médicas|NOVA Medical School, Universidade NOVA de Lisboa.

1 — The Doctorate to be hired will perform within the scope of the base funding of the CHRC Unit the following functions:

- a) Actively seek and publicize funding opportunities appropriate to the thematic lines, research group and/or managing institutions of the R&D unit;
- b) Manage and promote support at all stages of the funding application process for researchers who are members of the R&D unit and/or all managing institutions of the R&D unit: support in the preparation of the proposal, review and respective submission;

- c) Manage the processes of negotiation and signing of financing contracts;
- d) Articulation and mediation with funding entities during the application and negotiation processes;
- e) Articulation with the other services of the R&D unit and all its management institutions during the application and negotiation processes;
- f) Participation in training sessions for the preparation, submission and negotiation of funding applications;
- g) Organization of information sessions, workshops and meetings to support the preparation and submission of funding applications;
- h) Monitor, collect and systematize information on applications for funding and funding granted;
- i) Promote the appreciation of knowledge, products and services in health or technology-based;
- j) Participation in national and international networks with similar structures.

## 2 — General requirements of the application:

- a) Portuguese nationals, foreigners or stateless persons, holding a PhD degree in health sciences, biochemistry or related field;
- b) Holders of a scientific and professional curriculum that reveals an adequate profile for the activity to be developed.

If the PhD has been awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 341/2007, of October 12, and any formalities established there must be fulfilled until the formalization of job contract.

## 3 — Specific requirements of the application:

- a) More than 7 years experience with public and private institutions, funding science and research
- b) Experience of more than 5 years in the coordination of scientific research projects;
- c) Proven knowledge of intellectual property;
- d) Proven knowledge in continuous improvement of organizations;
- e) Proven knowledge in the process of valuing technology-based products and/or services.

#### 4 — Contracting:

The contracting is made through a fixed uncertain term work contract under the Labor Code, as a PhD holder, and is remunerated according to remuneration level 38 of the single remuneration table (TRU), pursuant to article 5 of Regulatory Decree no. 11-A/2017, of 29 December.

#### 5 —Place of work:

The workplace is located on the Chronic Diseases Research Center (CEDOC), Faculdade de Ciências Médicas|NOVA Medical School - UNL, Rua Câmara Pestana n.º 6, 1150-082 Lisboa.

#### 6 —Documents that must instruct the application:

- i) Motivation Letter;
- ii) Detailed Curriculum vitae according to the application requirements;
- iii) Copy of PhD certificate or diploma;
- iv) Other relevant documents for assessing the adequacy of the requested profile.

#### 7 — Methods of selection and definition of the respective weights:

- a) The curricular evaluation will be performed in a numerical scale ranging from 0 to 20 and will consider the items i) and ii) defined above ascribing the following ponderation: i) Motivation Letter (30%); ii) Detailed Curriculum vitae (70%).
- b) If deemed necessary by the jury, the top three candidates will be selected for an individual interview.
- c) In this latter case, the curricular evaluation will have a weight of 90% and the interview a weight of 10%. The final classification of each individual candidate will result from the average of the evaluations provided by the jury members.
- d) In case there is no interview, the final classification will be equal to the classification obtained in the curriculum evaluation.
- e) In the case of a tie, it is incumbent to the president of the jury to choose the candidate.
- f) In accordance with Decree-Law no. 29/2001, of February 3, candidates with disabilities are favored when equally classified. This prevails above any other legal preference. The candidates must declare their type and degree of disability in their motivation letter, as well as the means of communication/expression to be used in the selection process.

8 — In accordance with article 13 of Decree-Law no. 57/2016, of August 29, the Jury is composed as follows:

9 —Notification of candidates:

Candidates are notified by e-mail.

11 — Application deadline:
